

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how **Duronis d.o.o Belgrade** ("Duronis," "we," "us," or "our"), the company operating **AntiScam Monitor** (the "Platform"), available at <https://antiscamonitor.com/> and <app.antiscamonitor.com> (together, the "Service"), collects, uses, and protects your information.

By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

1. Who We Are

AntiScam Monitor is operated by **Duronis d.o.o Belgrade**, a company registered in the Republic of Serbia. For any privacy-related questions, you can contact us using the details in Section 12 below.

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Information you provide directly

- **Account information:** username, email address, and a securely hashed password when you register.
- **Payment information:** if you subscribe to the Pro Plan (\$99/year), payment is made directly to us in cryptocurrency. We do not accept credit/debit card payments or bank transfers, and we do not collect or store any card or bank account details. To process your payment, we collect the wallet address you pay from and the associated transaction hash, which are used to verify and confirm your subscription.
- **Project submissions:** if you register or claim a project listing on behalf of a token team, we collect the information you voluntarily submit, which may include allocation breakdowns, wallet addresses, vesting and locking details, team identity information, and related documentation.
- **Support and bug reports:** information you submit through our "Report an Issue" feature, including your description, any attached screenshots, and device/app version details.
- **Communications:** if you contact us directly (e.g., by email or through X/Twitter), we retain that correspondence.

2.2 Information collected automatically

- **Usage data:** pages and screens viewed, features used, tokens searched or watchlisted, and timestamps.
- **Device and log data:** IP address, browser type, operating system, and app version, collected automatically for security and diagnostic purposes.
- **Cookies and similar technologies:** used to keep you signed in, remember preferences, and understand how the Service is used (see Section 6).

2.3 Publicly available blockchain data

We also process publicly available on-chain data (e.g., contract addresses, token holder distributions, transaction activity) to generate Trust Scores and related metrics. This data is not personal data about you as a user, it relates to blockchain addresses and tokens, not identified individuals, unless you voluntarily associate your identity with a wallet address through a project submission.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Create and manage your account;
- Provide and improve the Service, including the Free Plan and Pro Plan;
- Generate and display Trust Scores, Monitor Grades, Risk Levels, and related analytics;
- Process payments and manage subscriptions;
- Respond to support requests and bug reports;
- Review and verify project submissions from token teams;
- Send you service-related communications (e.g., alerts you've opted into, such as unlock events, whale movement, or score changes);
- Detect, investigate, and prevent fraud, abuse, or security incidents;
- Comply with applicable legal obligations.

We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

4. Legal Basis for Processing (EEA/UK Users)

If you are located in the European Economic Area or the United Kingdom, we process your personal data on the following legal bases: performance of a contract (to provide the Service you signed up for), your consent (e.g., for optional alerts or marketing communications), our legitimate interests (e.g., improving and securing the Service), and compliance with legal obligations.

5. How We Share Information

We may share information with:

- **Service providers** who help us operate the Platform, such as hosting providers, payment processors, and analytics providers, under appropriate confidentiality and data protection obligations;
 - **Project teams**, only in relation to information you voluntarily submit about a project you represent, which may be displayed publicly on the Platform (e.g., allocation and vesting details you choose to disclose);
 - **Legal and regulatory authorities**, if required by law, regulation, or legal process, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Duronis, our users, or the public;
 - **Business transfers**, if Duronis is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, in which case your information may be transferred as part of that transaction.
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6. Cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to keep you logged in, remember your preferences, and understand usage patterns on the Service. You can control cookies through your browser settings; disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of the Service.

7. Data Retention

We retain your personal information for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide the Service, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements. You may request deletion of your account and associated personal data at any time, subject to Section 8.

8. Your Rights

Depending on your location, you may have the right to:

- Access the personal data we hold about you;
- Request correction of inaccurate data;
- Request deletion of your data;
- Object to or restrict certain processing;
- Request a copy of your data in a portable format;
- Withdraw consent at any time, where processing is based on consent.

To exercise these rights, contact us using the details in Section 12. We may need to verify your identity before fulfilling certain requests.

9. Data Security

We implement reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, or misuse. However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

10. Children's Privacy

The Service is not directed to individuals under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect personal information from minors. If you believe a minor has provided us with personal information, please contact us so we can remove it.

11. International Data Transfers

Your information may be processed and stored in countries other than your own, including Serbia and countries where our service providers operate. Where required, we take steps to ensure such transfers are subject to appropriate safeguards.
